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

### Fostering Positive Relationships

- Stop voicing programmatic injustices to your students
  - Budgets are a big source of contention, be innovative
- Help the student understand the value of teamwork
  - Include students from other programs in your college
- Lead by example with positive relationships at clinical sites and at the college
  - Establish go-to people at the clinical sites that can act as a liaison for students in each team role
    - Surgical Tech, Circulator, Attendant, SPD...
