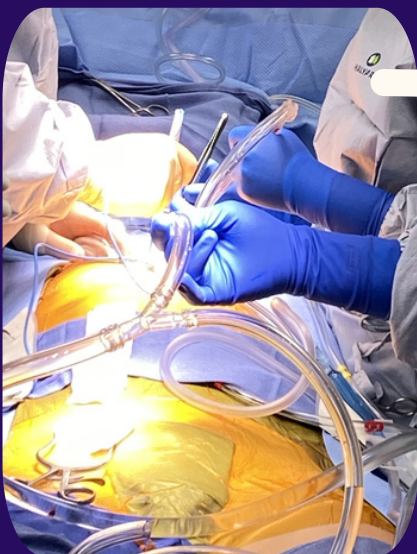


Sara Stone Barnhart

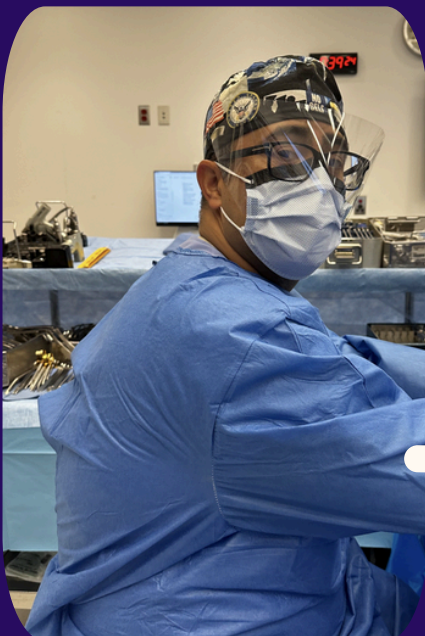


Nellie Shirah
