- 34. Operating Room Technician. A person who: (12-31-91)
 - a. Has successfully completed a one (1) year education program for operating room technicians accredited by the Committee on Allied Health Education and Accreditation of the American Medical Association (now <u>CAAHEP</u>) in cooperation with the Joint Review Committee on Education for the Operating Room Technician (now the ARC/STSA), or meets the requirements for certification (CST) by the Association of Surgical Technologists (now administered by the <u>National Board of Surgical Technology and</u> <u>Surgical Assisting</u>); or (10-14-88)

b. Is licensed as a practical (vocational) nurse in the state of Idaho and meets the training requirements of the Idaho State Board of Nursing
