Delegates and alternates shall be active members *elected* by the state assembly general membership.

By the AST National and State Assembly Bylaws, each state is entitled to six (6) delegates and up to six (6) alternates, provided the assembly is in good standing as defined in the AST Policy Manual. Voting by delegates shall be in person, and each is delegate entitled to one vote.

Eligibility to Vote

A member must be current in their AST membership dues and certification through the National Board of Surgical Technology & Surgical Assisting (NBSTSA) as a Certified Surgical Technologist (CST). A CSFA only who is not a CST and Pre77's without currency are not eligible to vote.

Listed are names of eligible members interested in representing your state assembly at the AST Annual National Conference. Please cast your vote and hand in your ballot to the teller. Mark an "X" or a checkmark in the box next to the name of the candidates of your choice. Do not put your name, initials, or any other identifying information on the ballot. Ballots containing any identifying information is void.

Elections of delegates and alternates shall be by a plurality vote. The first six (6) are the delegates; seven (7) through twelve (12) are the alternates.
